

The response of the Foundation to Battle Injustice to the Le Monde publication of September 14, 2021

On September 14, 2021, the French newspaper Le Monde released a negative publication about the Foundation to Battle Injustice authored by Benoît Vitkine. The author accused the Foundation of interfering in the internal affairs of France and attempting to finance information campaigns in the French media.

The Foundation officially rejects all the accusations published in the Le Monde article and regards them as slander and incitement. We are not interested in the French elections and the outcome of election doesn't matter anything to us. Our purpose is to help the victims of police violence and political persecution all over the world. We officially declare that the Foundation did not interfere into any affairs and did not pay anyone.

The publication of Le Monde, directed against the Foundation, is a violation of journalistic ethics and an attempt to distract attention from the important topic of police violence. In our opinion, the actual issue is that biased media and political puppets begin to throw a tantrum as soon as someone points out the fact of police terror, judicial arbitrariness and violence in prisons of the West. This indicates the total unwillingness of some influential individuals, organizations and state bodies to combat manifestations of police violence and racism in law enforcement agencies of the West. However, such provocations will never stand in our way; we intend to continue our activities - honestly and openly.

We officially declare that the Foundation did not interfere in any elections and did not finance information campaigns, both in France and in other Western countries.
