

Dear Iryna Valentinovna!

My name is Terada Mira Vladimirovna, I am the head of the Russian human rights organization Foundation to Battle Injustice, which is engaged in the struggle for the observance of human rights around the world. I am addressing you on the Day of Remembrance and Sorrow, a date sacred to our nations, and I bring to your attention information about violations by the administration of the Ukrainian website "Mirotvorets". According to the information available to me, in October 2021, the personal data of 13-year-old Faina Vladimirovna Savenkova, born in 2008, and her mother, Natalia Vladimirovna Savenkova, born in 1986, were published on the resource. The administration of the "Mirotvorets" portal violated Article 182 of the Criminal Code of Ukraine "Violation of privacy", namely illegal collection, storage and dissemination of confidential information about a person. According to the testimony of Faina Savenkova, immediately after the publication of her personal data and accounts on social networks, she began to receive threats of physical violence, she became afraid to move around the street on her own and was forced to turn to law enforcement agencies in order to obtain personal protection. Like the yellow star symbol that the Nazis forced ethnic Jews to wear during the Holocaust, the "Mirotvorets" website puts its stigma on innocent people, thereby humiliating their human dignity and putting their lives in serious danger.

Based on the above, I demand:

1. To check the activities of the "Mirotvorets" website for violations of Ukrainian legislation;
2. Immediately delete confidential information not only of minors and their family members, but also to achieve complete blocking of the specified resource.
